The study explores the current trends, challenges and opportunities that the use of new technologies brings to the CCS, as well as their impact on the participation and representation of women in the sector.

The research phase has already been concluded and we are publishing the findings very soon. We have reviewed the existing literature, as well as primary data collection through surveys and interviews with key stakeholders in the CCS. The analysis of the research findings will be used to inform the development of the Academy training program and the Virtual Exhibition as well as to provide a basis for policy recommendations and best practices in the CCS.
